David on the Run

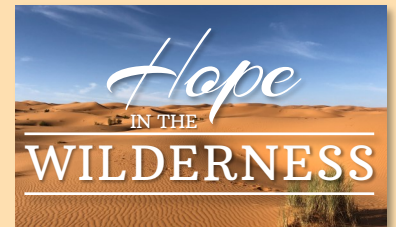
Psalm 63

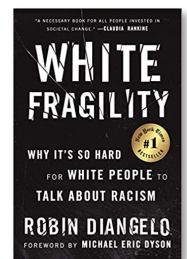

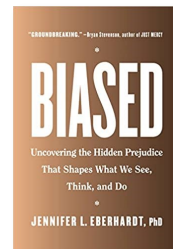

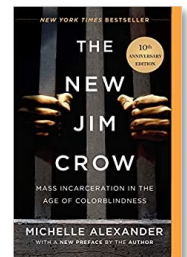
